Introduction

Over the past few years, GPSA has developed a large number of educational resources to assist supervisors in their role. These comprise a wide range of formats, including teaching plans, guides, webinars (and related FAQs), online learning modules and flash cards. They cover topics related to supervision, teaching and assessment, as well as core clinical content.

The most comprehensive educational resource covering clinical content are the teaching plans. These plans have been developed as an 'off-the-shelf' in-practice teaching resource for GP supervisors. They cover a wide breadth of common and serious clinical presentations and problems managed in Australian general practice. They include key references and exam-style questions.

Increasingly, the GPSA teaching plans have been recognised as a repository of high quality, up to date learning material directly relevant to GP registrars for independent preparation for College examinations.

Additionally, there are webinars, FAQs and other resources which cover clinical content.

GPSA has identified the need to collate all their educational resources to make them more accessible. As part of this process, this document has been developed to categorise the clinical educational resources. Its aim is to assist supervisors and registrars to incorporate these resources into in-practice teaching and examination study plans.

We have categorised the clinical resources into the following headings

- RACGP high risk presentations.
